

CARE GUIDE FOR QUARTZ AND NATURAL STONE

Below are some helpful tips and tricks to keep your stone looking new and protect it from unwanted damage.

Daily Routine and Preventative Maintenance

- Use warm water with a sponge or cloth with dish soap daily to clean up everyday messes. Do not use anything with an abrasive surface.
- Only use cleaning products that specifically state they are safe for your stone surfaces.

Do's of Stone Care

- **DO** blot up spills immediately.
- **DO** use coasters under drinking glasses.
- **DO** use place mats under servingware that may cause scratches on the surface when moved.
- **DO** use a trivet or hot pad under hot pans, pots, etc.
- **DO** use cleaners safe for stone
- **DO** contact Modern Countertops if you have a scratch, chip, or stain. Let us fix the problem.



Don'ts of Stone Care

- **DON'T** let spills sit. It greatly increases the chance of absorption into the stone.
- **DON'T** use abrasive cleaners.
- **DON'T** use vinegar, bleach, ammonia, or other general all-purpose cleaners.
- **DON'T** drag items across the stone's surface such as countertop appliances, heavy dishes, pans, etc.
- **DON'T** use scouring pads, pretreated sponges or powders. They can scratch and your stone's surface.
